Judges Criteria

Criteria to be applied in formulating the Clubs Judging List agreed by the Judging Sub-committee on 7th February 2015

B1 LIST (Breed Specialist).

Candidates **MUST** meet all the criteria below

[* Judges who award CC's need **not** provide proof of (d) and (e)]

- a) Have owned, exhibited or bred Coton de Tulear for at least 5 years.
- b) Have attended and passed a breed specific seminar assessed by experienced judges appointed by the Club and run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
- c) Have judged at least 20 dogs at Championship or Open Show level in Coton de Tulear and related breeds (*i.e. Havanese, Bolognese, Maltese and Bichon Frisé*),
- d) Have attended and passed the Kennel Club Requirements of a Dog Show Judge exam*
- e) Have attended and passed the Kennel Club Conformation and Movement and Hands on Assessment exam*.

B2 LIST (Non Breed specialist)

Candidates **MUST** meet criteria (a) **or** (b) below:

Or **ALL** (c) to (g) inclusive

[*Judges who award CC's need not provide proof of (e) and (f)]

- a) Have judged the Toy Group or Import Register Toy at Championship Show Level, **or**
- b) Are FCI approved judges who have judge the Coton de Tulear at Championship Show level.

- c) Have judged more than 40 dogs at Championship and Open Show level in Coton De Tulear and related breeds. (*i.e. Havanese, Bolognese, Maltese and Bichon Frisé*).

- d) Have attended and passed a breed specific seminar assessed by experienced judges appointed by the Club and run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
 - e) Have attended and passed the Kennel Club Requirements of a Dog Show Judge exam*.
 - f) Have attended and passed the Kennel Club Conformation and Movement and Hands on Assessment exam*.

C List

To be considered, specialist judges should have shown an interest in the breed and have had a minimum of two years' experience of owning and exhibiting in this breed, or for non-specialists, a minimum of three years' experience of owning and exhibiting in any breed.
